



## Fee Schedule 2026

### Application Fee

A non-refundable application fee of R520 is payable on return of the Application Form.

### Non-Refundable Acceptance Fee

A once off Non-Refundable Acceptance Fee of R11 000 per child is payable upon accepting an offer of place for your child/ren at the school. The Acceptance Fee contributes towards capital development projects in the school. Placement at Clifton will only be guaranteed once the Acceptance Fee has been paid and all the required forms correctly signed and submitted.

The payment of the Acceptance Fee for the Pre-Primary is due in two instalments:

- Payment 1: R1 500 payable on confirmation of acceptance,
- Payment 2: Balance of R9 500 upon promotion to Grade 0, at which point it becomes due.

## Non-South African Resident Pupils

Rigid Exchange Control regulations require a non-interest-bearing, full-term's fee (in addition to the usual Acceptance Fee) to be paid to the school before a pupil who is a resident of a country outside the borders of South Africa may be admitted to the school. This rule also applies to local parents paying in a foreign currency.

### Extras Levy (As per table)

This Levy covers Personal Accident insurance, grade school trips (including the Grade 7 trip to Botswana), textbooks and workbooks, printing and photocopying, school magazine, school photographs, visiting arts and cultural performers, selected invited speakers, library subscription (grade one), IT access, IEB benchmarking tests etc.

The Extras Levy does not cover specialized learning support fees (Occupational Therapist, Speech Therapist, Remedial Therapist, Play Therapy, Facilitators and Educational Psychologist), riding school costs, purchases from the school shop, optional termly hikes, tuck shop purchases, visiting book sales.

### Capital Development Levy (Per Family – Applicable from Grade 1 – 7)

This Levy is charged per family and is payable in advance, either annually, quarterly, or monthly. (See the above table). This Levy provides improvements of a capital nature to the school.

### Day Scholar Meals

A mid-morning snack and juice is provided to all pupils. Lunch is provided to all Grade 1 - 7 pupils. Lunch is available for Pre-Primary to Grade 0 pupils at a cost of R35 per meal and will be added to the school account. Requests for these meals must be booked in advance through the Junior Primary HOD on a quarterly basis.

### Daily Boarding Rate

Day scholars are allowed to stay overnight in boarding, when necessary, at a daily rate of R370. For stays exceeding two weeks, the charge will be at the pro-rata boarding fee.

### Howick Bus

Daily transport is available. Enquiries to be made with the School Secretary. Booking is essential as seating is limited.

### Johannesburg / Lesotho / Durban Bus

Transport is available to Johannesburg, Clarens, and Durban at the start and end of each term, as well as during mid-term breaks, except for the start of Term 1 and the end of Term 4. Arrangements must be made in advance with the School Secretary. Booking is essential, as a minimum number of pupils must apply before the trip can be confirmed.

### Special Trips / Transportation for Boarders

This service is offered by prior arrangement with the School Secretary. Transport rates will apply.

Transport rates for 2026 will be published in January 2026. Please note that rates may change during the year. Any changes in rates will be published as required.



## Payment of Fees

Tuition and boarding fees must be paid via one of the following three methods:

1. **Monthly in advance** by variable debit order over the 11-month period, January – November. Payments are due by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month.
2. **Quarterly in advance** by variable debit order with full payment due on the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month the invoice is raised (January, April, July, October).
3. **Annually in advance**. An early settlement discount of 3.5% is available for families who pay the full annual tuition and boarding fees upfront before Monday, January 12, 2026.

A R250 administration fee will be added to the school account if a debit order is returned by the Bank. Any other method of fee payment is strictly by arrangement between the School Business Manager and the person responsible for the payment of the school fees. All accounts are to be paid by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

Overdue accounts will be charged interest at the rate of 2.5% per month.

Account statements are emailed on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month. It is the parent / guardian's responsibility to notify the Business Manager's office timeously ([accounts@cliftonprep.org.za](mailto:accounts@cliftonprep.org.za)) if your statement has not been received. It is also the parent / guardian's responsibility to ensure that the Business Manager is informed of any changes to your contact details.

## Family Discount

A family discount of 7% is allowed on the total tuition and boarding fees when there are more than three children from the same family enrolled at the school at the same time. (This is applicable for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> child).

## Notice of Withdrawal

A full term's notice in writing is required when removing a child from the school, boarding house, or riding school. Should such notice not be given, a full term's fees will be payable in lieu of such notice.

## Notice of Conversion from Boarding to Day Scholar

A full month's notice in writing is required when converting from a boarder to day scholar. Should such notice not be given, a full month's fees will be payable in lieu of such notice.

## Payments / Deposits

Payments / deposits made into the school account must be referenced with the school fees account number i.e., ABC001.
